In keeping with the Fulbright-Hays GPA scholarship requirements, your international flight must be on an American carrier. However, if your international flight involves a domestic connecting flight in China, this domestic flight can be on a non-American carrier.

You will need a valid passport for at least six months after your last day in China. If your passport does not meet this requirement, please be sure to renew it as soon as possible. If you do not have a passport, you should apply for one immediately.

## **Teaching Plan**

A significant element of this program is for each participant to develop an extensive teaching plan comprised of a full unit with 4-6 lesson plans. In preparation, we ask that you send us a brief teaching plan proposal **by April 3.** This proposal should addess the anticipated theme, content, materials and assessment tools of your teaching plan.
