The French Centre for Research on Contemporary China (CEFC), based in Hong Kong, seeks a well-organized, energetic intern to carry out translations of the tables of contents and abstracts of research articles published in *China Perspectives* (4 issues per year) from English or French into Chinese language.

The CEFC is part of a network of 27 research institutions established around the world with funding from the French Foreign Ministry and the CNRS (French Centre for Scientific Research). It functions both as an independent academic institution hosting individual research projects, and as a think tank devoted to analyzing current developments in contemporary China. It publishes a quarterly peer-reviewed journal in two languages (French and English), *China Perspectives* and *Perspectives chinoises*.

Applicants should be interested in working in a friendly, high-paced, collaborative, academic environment, and have a strong academic interest in contemporary China. (e.g. politics, economics, society, international relations) and / or PRC and Hong Kong press.

### **Job Description**

The intern will work closely with the CEFC researchers:

- She / He will translate the tables of contents and abstracts of research articles published in *China Perspectives* (4 issues per year) from English into Chinese language.
- She / He will have the opportunity to attend the Centre's event, which may include lectures, workshops and international academic conference.

### Qualifications

- The candidate should hold a bachelor degree in a relevant field, current master degree student preferred (journalism, political sciences, economics, international relations, or another academic field), and should ideally have conducted research on China.
- The candidate must be fluent in English and Mandarin, with familiarity of both traditional and simplified characters; and excellent writing and communication skills in both languages. Good computer skills are essential.

### Compensation

- Unfortunately, CEFC cannot pay its intern, but CEFC resources and networks will be available to the intern for his/her own research activities.
